ADVANCEMENT POINTS

The district provides a system for determining rider skill level and a formal recognition of achievement. Riders are advanced from C (the lowest skill level) to A (the highest skill level) as they accumulate "advancement points". Points are earned by race finishes.

Points are carried forward when the rider advances with the exception that peewee riders revert to c when they move to mini.

ADVANCEMENT PROCESS

Advancement points are solely managed by the District Steward. Riders are moved up when they reach the threshold. When a rider reaches the next level, the Steward notifies the District 36 Membership Director, Jill Patterson. Processing a card takes approximately two weeks, so you may be moved up at your next race without being in receipt of your card.

ADVANCEMENT SCHEDULE:

"C"--less than 30 points

"B"--between 30 and 70 points

"A"--over 70 points

MINI/PEEWEE ADVANCEMENT SCHEDULE:

"C"--0 to 19

"B"--20 to 39

"A"--Over 40

Mini "A" riders with 100 points as an "A" rider, may petition the Steward for admission to the "Sportsman" ranks as a "B" rather than a "C".

ADVANCEMENT POINTS POSTING:

Advancement points are publicly and readily available via the three following sources:

TROPHIES

Trophy distribution will be based on the number of riders entered in the event. The following shall be the minimum trophy distribution for all categories. One (1) trophy for the class and one (1) for each five (5) riders or major portion thereof in that class.

Any promoter or club may give bonus trophies at their option, however, District 36 advancement and championship points will not be given for these bonus trophies.
